The Gospel to Every Home



"For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another" (Galatians 5:13 KJV).

Jesus has called each one of us into a life of liberty, to not live out of legal bondage, but out of our bondage to the Lordship of Jesus Christ (John 8:32,36). Do not let your liberty lead to licentiousness, but rather let it lead to a life of service to God. We serve Him because He first served us by humbly coming to earth as God in the flesh to die for our sins.

Today, choose to answer the call to liberty. Do not let anything or anyone hold you in bondage. Do not let fear of the Coronavirus pandemic keep you in emotional chains. Let your freedom in Christ show others that God loves them and desires a relationship with them. Do not let uneasiness around those who appear different than you become chains of silence. Tell all people about God's love and show all people God's love.

One of the best ways to serve one another in love is to make plans to participate in Gospel to Every Home (GTEH). We have enough material to saturate every home in Daviess county, McLean county, and Hartford, Kentucky. We need as many churches as possible to say, "Yes, count us in." What will it entail? Adopting a mapped area around your church. Prayer walking the streets in the mapped area. At a later date delivering to those homes a GTEH packet which will include a Jesus film in 8 languages, a gospel tract, a piece from the KBC explaining why this is on their door, and a piece that each church can customize to place in the bag.

Every person in your church can get involved with GTEH. For those who cannot walk they can put the packets together. For those who can walk but feel uncomfortable talking to strangers they can join in the prayer walking. And for those who get excited about the idea of every home receiving a gospel presentation, they can take part in the distribution.
